To support the mission of Delta Kappa Gamma Society International, Theta Lambda Chapter makes yearly contributions to funds at both the State and International levels.

Alpha State Texas Educational Foundation (ASTEF) is the fundraising entity that assists Texas State Organization in fulfilling its purposes by accepting and distributing money for Scholarships, Leadership and Projects.

The <u>Scholarship Fund</u> provides scholarships for members who wish to pursue graduate studies, continuing adult education, and educational travel.

The <u>Leadership Fund</u> provides opportunities for professional and personal growth of members which is beneficial to both the individual member and the Society.

The <u>Projects Fund</u> awards stipends for innovative ideas that will make a difference for Texas educators and students.

Another State fund we contribute to is the <u>Eula Lee Carter Memorial Fund</u> which provides scholarships for members residing in a Latin American Country who wish to further their educational advancement.

In addition, there are many International funds available for donations. Our executive board has approved contributions to the following:

<u>The Educational Projects Fund</u> provides funds to support projects that carry out the mission of DKGIEF (Delta Kappa Gamma International Educators Foundation).

<u>The Emergency Fund</u> provides aid to members who have sustained major losses from natural disasters.

<u>The Golden Gift Fund</u> is a stipend given to members attending the Leadership Management Seminar.

<u>The International Speaker's Fund</u> facilitates and funds the exchange of Society speakers among member countries.

<u>The World Fellowship Fund</u> provides aid and fellowships for women in other countries to pursue advanced study in the U.S. and Canada.

<u>Schools for Africa</u> is an international partnership program between UNICEF and the Nelson Mandela Foundation which helps the children of Africa receive a quality education.



Theta Lambda Membership Plan 2023-2024

- * When a guest attends a meeting for the first time, she will receive a welcome note, brochure and Theta Lambda Guest Card to complete. The member who brought that guest will receive a thank you note at the meeting.
- * The first time guest will receive a hand written note in the mail.
- * Prospect letter template will be available to be completed by member for their specific guest and prospect cards will be available for members to hand out to prospective members at school, church, etc.
- * Brochures with be available for members to hand out to prospective members.
- * Review that women eligible for membership in DKG include teachers, administrators, counselors, librarians, and paraprofessionals as well as music teachers like piano and violin who teach as a job either privately or with groups, health educators like yoga and exercise instructors who teach as a job either privately or with groups, adult educators, and trainers in business world.
